F&A was retained by the City of Newburgh and the Newburgh Preservation Association to conduct a feasibility study to determine the most appropriate re-use of the Dutch Reformed Church, a 170-year old national landmarked building near the City's downtown. Working with Stephen Tilly, a nationally renowned preservation architect, F&A conducted outreach and design charettes to elicit public input on market and community based uses. The goal was to make the building, long vacant, economically viable and an anchor for the neighborhood. The study was funded through a grant from the Dyson foundation and has been completed.
