F&A recently prepared the Consolidated Plan for Housing and Community Development Programs, consistent with HUD guidelines and objectives, for the City of Meriden, Connecticut with a population of 60,868 in 2010. The Consolidated Plan is a long range strategic plan that includes analysis of the City's housing market, identification of housing and community development needs of low and moderate income households, as well as the resources to address those needs, and establishment of priorities to fund programs to meet these needs. A strategic plan for revitalization within a local and regional context was developed (integrating economic, physical, environmental, community and human development components) to identify long term goals, specific objectives, annual goals and benchmarks for measuring progress. As part of the Plan, an annual action plan that identifies resources to be used to address priority program objectives was completed. Meriden receives \$930,000 in CDBG funds annually.
