MUSIC CONSERVATORY OF WESTCHESTER

- F&A completed a feasibility study to relocate and expand the Music Conservatory of Westchester into a Center for Arts and Culture, in downtown White Plains. The study included land use and architectural analysis of alternate sites, a marketing and strategic plan for the Conservatory and an economic impact analysis. Funds for the study were provided by the National Endowment for the Arts.
- F&A prepared an application for The Music Conservatory for funding under New York State's Community Enhancement Facilities Fund. These funds provide assistance for the construction of capital facilities that benefit the community, particularly with regard to the arts, culture, education, recreation, transportation and economic development. Awarded \$150,000, the Conservatory applied the grant toward an \$11 million purchase and rehabilitation of a building on the outskirts of downtown White Plains to serve as its new home.
